THE PROJECT GOALS

- In the framework of a socially fair and just transition to the Green Economy (GE) in the EU, this project aims to create a COP and a workshop training approach for VET, to promote the ideation and development of new circular business models, supporting the creation of micro and small companies (and jobs) for the circular economy by the VET learners. The project particularly addresses the disadvantaged people needs and promote their inclusion in the socially fair transition to the GE.
- 1. Contribute to a socially fair transition to the green economy in EU, promoting the inclusion and diversity through entrepreneurship for circular economy.
- 2. Enable VET learners with fewer opportunities to work in the circular economy.
- Development of green entrepreneurship and circular business models development competences amongst partners, teachers and trainers in VET.
- 4. Increase the training offer for VET in green entrepreneurship and circular business models.

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THE FLC COMMUNITY OF PRACTICE

The FLC Community of Practice (COP) includes people from the partnership and other external partners invited to participate, to debate and share resources in entrepreneurship (green, social, micro and female), and circular business models.

THE FLC TRAINING WORKSHOP
